**Qualifications:** Students must have excellent organizational and people skills. Applicants should have a background or strong interest in marine science and/or policy, as well as have strong on-line publishing skills. Minimum required skills include a working proficiency in Dreamweaver and Photoshop; a working understanding of FTP servers, graphic manipulation, and webpage layout; and solid writing skills. Additional desired skills include experience with blog creation/maintenance, advanced graphic skills (inclusive of working with Flash), and web design. The ability to work independently and as part of a team is a must.
